In the Spring of 2019...

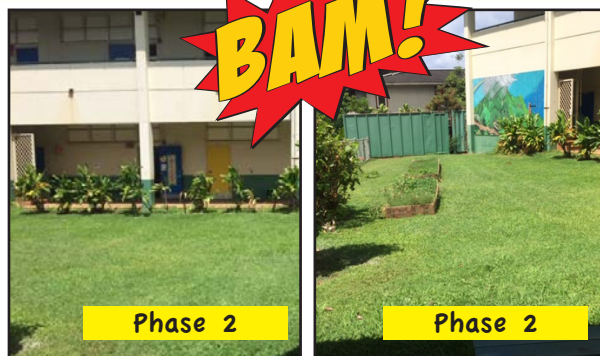
MSCF met our 3-year fundraising goal and raised \$109,000 to renovate the Gr. 2/3 playground, which was the only field not included in Ma'ema'e School's State Capital Improvement Project budget.

HOWEVER, with last minute State of Hawaii/DOE mandates raising the retaining wall by 8", now required the unexpected additions of a fence, safety padding, more fill and stairs.

UNFORTUNATELY, these new additions ate all of our 3-year budget and MORE!*

MSCF had no choice but to split the Grade 2 and 3 playground renovation into two phases.

*(Mahalo to our Ma'ema'e PTSA for being our Phase I Super Hero by funding a great portion of the project and deficit!)



UNPERTURBED, MSCF is powering through this setback by extending our fundraising efforts to complete the full renovation for our keiki!!! WE MUST RAISE \$50,000 to complete Phase II by July 2020!

 - Promoting hands on learning and STEM activities

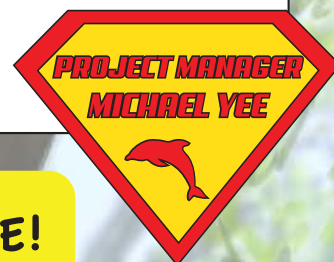
